Editorial - An image to represent member care

I was recently asked to choose an image to represent member care. Two of the options were helping someone climb a mountain and two people sitting, one talking, one listening intently. I wonder what image member care conjures up for you? Even the language is a problem for many of us – a jumble of arms and legs being tended too? The members of an organisation being read their rights! In many ways it's an unhelpful phrase, the more so if your first language is not English!

However, I continue to have confidence in and be helped by the definition adopted by the GMCN. This states that member care is:

The ongoing preparation, equipping and empowering of Missionaries for effective and sustainable life, ministry and work."

I like the statement because it is robust, comprehensive in time and scope and assumes what I would call a 'paraclete' dimension – a coming alongside to enable and encourage, to listen and support, to provoke and resource. I have been encouraged in travels to newer sending countries to hear them say 'We want Member Care in our DNA from the start'. This, I think, reflects that member care, at local, national and international is more of an organism than an organisation. And within our communities we need to breathe and breed member care into the organisations and people we serve.

- Compass Ministries, a division of D & D Missionary Homes, is now accepting applications for residency at Compass House. Young adult MKs, especially those who are just now returning to live in the US after growing up abroad, are invited to apply for very affordable housing on the grounds of D & D. Compass House offers independent dorm-style living with a Resident Advisor, who is also a TCK. We have one house for men, and another for women. Residents receive Member Care support as they negotiate the adjustment to the American culture. Compass House is an easy drive or bus ride to Clearwater Christian College, Eckerd College, St. Petersburg College, and the University of South Florida (Bayboro campus). Member Care Services now available at D & D Missionary Homes

- Compass Ministries, a division of D & D Missionary Homes provides a number of member care services to missionaries living at D & D in St. Petersburg, FL. About 200 missionary families live at D & D each year, some for a few weeks, and some for a full year. The houses are fully furnished, including linens and kitchen tools. Now, in addition to meeting missionary housing needs, on-site member care is available at no additional cost. Services that are available include Personal Debriefing, Family Debriefing, Play Therapy, training in Filial Therapy, Marital Counseling and seminars for Spiritual Renewal.
